## "Giddy-Up and Go" Transportation Form

For the upcoming school year, parents will complete a "Giddy-Up and Go" Transportation form on Registration Day to indicate how children will be transported home during the school year. This form helps us in preparing for the upcoming year.

For walkers, our procedures are changing. Parents will be required to complete a form that will indicate whether the child will be escorted by an adult or the child will be given permission to be unescorted. Parents will be required to show our dismissal hang tags to pick up walkers that are designate as "escorted walkers". Staff will not release students to adults unless he/she has the hang tag.

On the first day of school, please make arrangements for your child to go home the way he/she will all year long. It is much simpler to develop routines with the students if we start on the first day.
