Rhythm- can be created by repeating objects

Pattern- is repeating an object, such as a line.

Shape- 2-D- Flat

Form- 3-D- not flat- like a sculpture

Organic shapes- found in nature

Unity- is harmony in piece of artwork. The artwork looks complete.

Abstract/Non-objective- the artwork does not look like real life

One-point perspective- shows how things disappear to an imaginary point.

Red, yellow, blue-primary colors

Orange, green, purple-secondary colors

Warm colors-red, yellow, orange

Cool colors-blue, green, purple

Tertiary/intermediate colors- one primary and one secondary color mixed together. For example- yellow and orange, red and orange, blue and green

Compliment colors- Orange and blue, red and green, Yellow and purple

Symmetrical balance- is the same on both sides +|+

Asymmetrical balance- not same on both sides +|-

Utilitarian- artwork that's functional/ you can use it
For example- 3d sculptures like a bowl, plate and desk
