Fourth Quarter Report Cards

This year, fourth quarter report cards will be available online in the myStudent portal after final state assessment data is received and loaded into the student information system. What this means for families is that paper report cards will not be mailed home; report cards will only be accessed in the parent and student portals of myStudent. We expect to receive state assessment results by the end of June. Report cards will be available shortly thereafter. We will notify all families by phone message when report cards become available for families to view. In order to access the fourth quarter report cards, it is essential for parents to have a myStudent account already set up. To create a parent account, go to the district website at www.pascoschools.org and click on the parent link at the top. Then click on the Parent Access to the myStudent link below the video.
