IG readers can:

- Recognize at least 25 Power Words at flash speed.
- Make the primary sound for each consonant
- Read and comprehend IG text
- Ask and answer questions about key details

While working in this level, IG readers learn to:

- Retell familiar stories, including key details
- Identify the main topic and retell key details of a text
- Identify characters, settings, and major events in a story
- Describe the connection between two individuals, events, ideas or pieces of information in a text.
- Ask and answer questions about unknown words
- Recognize stories, poems, and informational texts
- Identify the front cover, back cover, and title page.
- Name the author and illustrator and define their role.
- Make predictions based on title, cover, illustrations, and text
- Make text to self connections
- Tell something they liked about the book
- Describe the relationship between illustrations and text.
- Identify reasons an author gives to support points
- Compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters
- Identify the similarities and differences between two texts on the same topic.
- Recognize and name all upper and lower-case letters
- Read at least 60 Power Words
