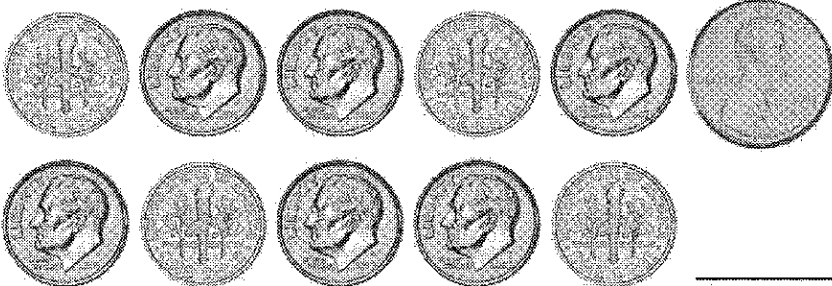
1. Find the value of each set of coins. Complete the place value chart.

Write an addition sentence to add the value of the dimes and the value of the pennies.

1 dime = 1 ten.

There are 10 dimes, so there are 10 tens.

1 penny = 1 one.



tens	ones
10	1

$100 + 1 = 101$

10 tens + 1 one is the same as  $100 + 1$ .

$$100 + 1 = 101$$

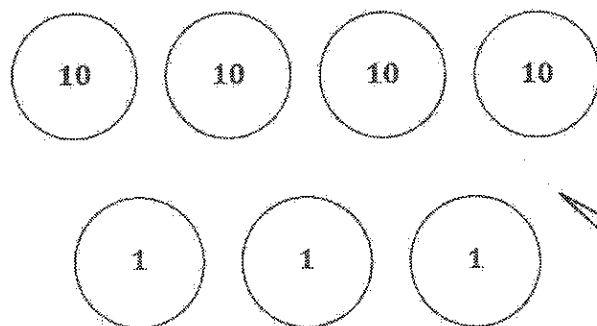
2. Check the set that shows the same amount. Fill in the place value chart to match 100 cents.

There are 8 dimes and 2 pennies,  
so there are 8 tens and 2 ones:  
 $80 + 2 = 82$ .  
This set shows 82 cents.

tens	ones
10	0

There are 10 dimes and 0 pennies,  
so there are 10 tens and 0 ones:  
 $100 + 0 = 100$ .  
This set shows 100 cents.

3. Draw 43 cents using dimes and pennies. Fill in the place value chart to match.



tens	ones
4	3

I can make 43 cents with  
4 dimes and 3 pennies.  
That's 4 tens and 3 ones!
