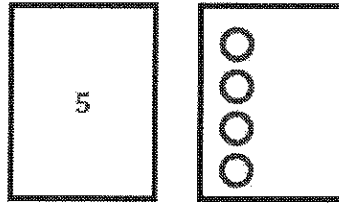


### G1-M1-Lesson 12

1. Use your 5-group cards to count on to find the missing number in the number sentences.

$$\boxed{5} + \boxed{?} = \boxed{9}$$

The mystery number is  $\boxed{4}$

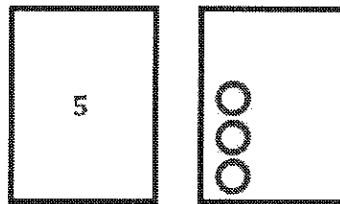


I can *count on* from 5 to find the mystery number.  
Fiiiiive..., 6, 7, 8, 9.  
I counted on 4 more, so the mystery number is 4.

2. Shana had 5 hats. Then she bought some more.  
She has 8 hats now. How many hats did she buy?

5 plus "the mystery number" equals 8.  
Hmmm...

I can start at 5 and draw dots as I *count on* to 8.  
Fiiiiive..., 6, 7, 8.



$$\boxed{5} + \boxed{3} = \boxed{8}$$

I drew 3 more dots.  
The "mystery number" is 3.

Shana bought 3 hats.
