

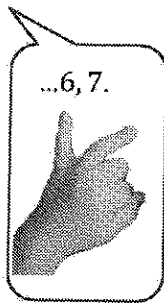

1.

$$\boxed{5} + \boxed{2} = \boxed{7}$$

I'll start at 5 and count on 2 fingers. Fiiiiive...



Show the shortcut you used to add.

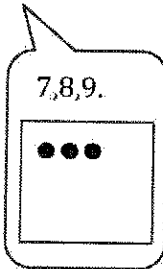
$$\boxed{5} + \boxed{2} = \boxed{7}$$

I used my fingers as a shortcut, so I'll draw them!

2.

$$\boxed{6} + \boxed{3} = \boxed{9}$$

I'll start at 6 and count the three dots on my five group card. Siiiiix...
