Solve the problems. Write your answers to show how many tens and ones.
Show your solution in two steps:

Step 1: Write one number sentence to subtract from ten.

Step 2: Write one number sentence to add the remaining parts.

$$\begin{array}{|c|c|} \hline 1 & 5 \\ \hline \end{array} - 9 = 6$$

$$\underline{10} - \underline{9} = \underline{1}$$

$$\underline{1} + \underline{5} = \underline{6}$$

15 is made of 10 and 5. I
can take 9 from 10 quickly.
 $10 - 9 = 1$

Then I can add 1 to the 5 I
didn't touch. $1 + 5 = 6$
