



School Health Requirements

For Attendance 2022-23

The school year begins Wednesday, August 10, 2022. Prepare now!

Have your children seen for an annual physical exam and review their immunizations.



A physical exam, signed and stamped by a licensed provider and dated within one year prior to registration, is required for each student initially entering a Florida school. This is proof that body systems (heart, skin, lungs) were examined.

✓ **DOH-Pasco will NOT be providing school physicals for the 2022-23 school year.**

Up-to-date immunizations are required, and all immunization dates must be on Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH680). Contact your physician or the DOH-Pasco for the form.

✓ **DOH-Pasco clinics provide free childhood immunizations. Appointments are required.**

Florida School Immunization Requirements 2022-23

Pre-Kindergarten	4 DTP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) 3 Polio 4 Hib (Haemophilus Influenzae Type B) 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) 3 Hepatitis B 1 Varicella (Chicken pox)
Kindergarten Grades 1 - 6	5 DTP (for KG, last dose on/after 4 th birthday) 4 Polio (last dose on/after 4 th birthday) 2 MMR 3 Hepatitis B 2 Varicella for KG and grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6
Grades 7 - 12	5 DTP 4 Polio (last dose on/after 4 th birthday) 2 MMR 3 Hepatitis B 1 TDaP 2 Varicella for grades 7, 8, 9, and 10 1 Varicella (chicken pox) for grades 11 - 12
